The Confession of Our Sins

O Lord Jesus Christ, in dying You destroyed our death, and rising You restored our life: we have reason for joy unceasing! But we confess that we linger in darkness, we stick to old paths, we cling to grudges, and choose fear instead of hope. O Lord, forgive our doubts and drive out our sins: as You were raised from the dead and now reign on high, pour out Your Holy Spirit and raise new hearts within us to follow You not with fear but with gladness and singleness of heart...(continue in silent confession)

The Gospel Promise of God's Forgiveness *from Romans 8:33-34*

"Who is in a position to condemn? Only Christ: and Christ died for us, Christ rose for us, Christ reigns in power for us, Christ prays for us." I declare to you in the name of the risen Christ: in Christ, you are forgiven! In Christ, you have peace with God!
